What is proposed bond measure 24-369?

Silver Falls School District has proposed a school bond designed to move students out of the Eugene Field School building

Specifically, the bond would fund:

- 1. Construction of additional classrooms and a cafeteria at Robert Frost School to serve Eugene Field School students (K-3)**
- 2. Construction of a covered play area at Mark Twain School to serve students in grades 4 and 5**
- 3. Removal of the original multi-story Schlador Street School building that has been decommissioned for school use by the School Board**
- 4. Construction of additional classrooms and reconstruction of the newer single-story portion of the Schlador Street Campus to serve students in grades 6 through 8 while continuing to house Community Roots Charter School**
- 5. Security and technology upgrades for all District elementary schools**

Why a school bond?

Community members have asked District leadership to make relocation of Eugene Field School students a top priority. The proposed bond construction projects will allow the District to move Eugene Field School students to the Robert Frost School building and discontinue use of the current facility. All District elementary schools are also in need of security and technology upgrades and improvements to serve the needs of students.

When are ballots due?

November 4, 2014

How much will the proposed school bond cost?

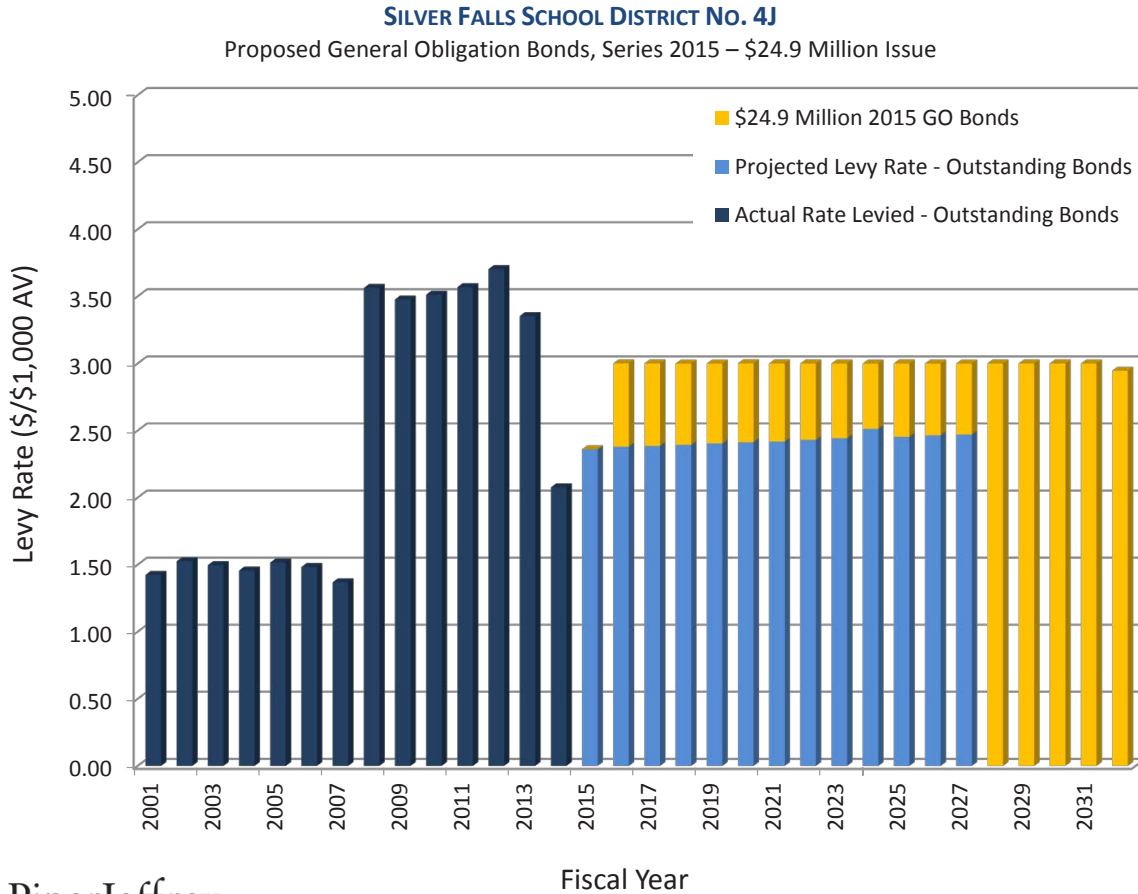
The proposed bond is for **\$24.9 million**. If passed by voters, property owners in the Silver Falls School District would be expected to pay a combined rate of \$3.00 or less per \$1,000 of assessed property value over the 17-year life of the bond (including interest and existing bond issues that funded the completion of Silverton High School).

Current 2015 Estimated Tax Rate

\$2.36 per \$1,000 of assessed property tax value

Proposed 2015 Estimated Tax Rate

\$3.00 or less per \$1,000 of assessed property value
